CONFESSION OF SIN—UNISON

In the flesh, even knowledge of Scripture becomes merely “brilliant wisdom” that contributes to our “somebodyness” rather than a means of becoming humbly, freshly dependent upon Father, Spirit, Jesus. O Spirit, freshly convict us this morning of wanting to become the heroes of our own life stories; re-orient our worship from self to you.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Beloved in Christ, your sins and the guilt of them have been destroyed by Jesus’ perfection and sacrifice! Hear and trust the Word of the Lord: “But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it— the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God’s righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus” (Romans 3:21-26).
